


The objectives of this organization shall be:

ABOUT US

The Jewish Genealogy Society of Greater Washington (JGSGW) was established as a non-profit society in 1980. In 1982, 1984, 1988, 1995, 2003 and 2011, JGSGW was the host society for the annual conference of the International Association of Jewish Genealogical Societies (IAJGS).

Library

The JGSGW maintains a collection of almost 2,000 books, published and unpublished works, microfiche, and CD-ROMs relevant to general and Jewish genealogy, including private collections of genealogical texts and papers. This collection is located at the B'nai Israel Congregation in Rockville, MD. The non-circulating library is open to society members during published hours on Wednesday afternoons, and one Sunday a month.

Publications

Our quarterly journal, *Mishpacha*, is emailed to members. It is free to members. Subscriptions are available to non-members for \$25 per year in the United States; \$30 elsewhere.

The latest edition of *Capital Collections* is the most comprehensive resource for Jewish genealogical research in the Washington, DC area; including Annapolis, Baltimore, and Richmond. Regular price \$25. Member price: \$15 (including U.S. postage). This new edition includes updated information about the many repositories in the area.

Meetings & Workshops

Meetings are generally held monthly on a Sunday, 8 – 10 times a year. Meeting content includes guest lectures, movies, and panel discussions on stimulating subjects to those interested in genealogy. Meeting notices are sent to members by email, unless noted.

Workshops are held frequently and are open only to members. Our Beginner's Workshop is taught by members of the Society and is geared as a comprehensive introduction to those getting involved in research. Other recent workshops include: "Intro to Family Tree Maker," "Using Jewishgen," and "Making the Most of the Steve Morse Website."

Research

JGSGW has a long history of performing research projects for the benefit of the genealogical community. Projects have included indexing of records of the State Department, local area cemeteries and funeral homes.

The current research project is to index the Jews buried in Arlington National Cemetery. We are building on donated research and have developed a website: http://anc.jgsgw.org.

Dues

The membership year begins on July 1. Dues for individuals are \$30 and families are \$45. There is a discount for 3-year membership: \$80 for individuals, \$120 for families. Patron membership is \$100 annually. A Life membership is \$500. Both Patron and Life memberships are for individuals or families, and are recognized in Society publications. The Society is certified as a non-profit corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and contributions may be tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.
